AGENDA ITEMS

Report from County Manager

The County Manager reported that the sales tax numbers look a little better. The County is looking at developing a Capital Improvement Plan. Renderings of the proposed future Agriculture Building are being done. The County has been awarded \$500,000.00 in grant funds for the 5-D park project but matching funds are required. The County Manager went over some of the activities that will be offered at 5-D when the park is developed.

Report from Superintendent

Dr. Hobbs spoke about the changes coming up in the schools. Changes in curriculum and testing could mean some changes in teaching methods. He thanked the Commissioners for all they did for the schools. The schools will be glad to take any available lottery or ADM funds that are available. They have some old buildings that need work and may need to be replaced. Dr. Hobbs spoke about the length of the school year and next year's school calendar. They expect to go from a short summer break to a longer summer break.

The Board of Commissioners and Board of Education discussed the next meeting. It was scheduled for December 31, 2012. That meeting will be rescheduled. The tentative rescheduled date is January 28, 2013.

The Board of Education had a motion and a second and voted to adjourn.
