

YADKIN COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS
Meeting of July 14, 2020

The Yadkin County Board of Elections met at 8:30 AM in the Yadkin County Board of Election's office. Walter Shore, Chair, Jeff Smith, Secretary, Claude Wiseman, Member, Ellen Reece, Member, Larry Vestal, Member, Elaine Barnes, Director, and Laurie Lankford, Assistant Director were in attendance.

Minutes were read and signed.

Walter Shore called the meeting to order.

Precinct Move Resolutions were signed by the board members and the director for the following moves:

Boonville-to the Boonville Elementary School form the Fire Dept.

Forbush-to the Forbush Fire Department from the Forbush Baptist Church-KMD Activity Center

North Fall Creek- to Fall Creek Elementary School from the Fall Creek Fire Dept.

North Liberty- to the Yadkinville Elementary School from the Senior Center

South Liberty-to the Courtney Elementary School from the Courtney Fire Dept

The state suggests to not combine precincts due to their experience in District 11 2nd Primary, but to open all precincts even if we need to relocate.

Claude made a motion to use James Williams printing to create and send notices to 12,065 voters to inform them of their precinct change. This motion passed.

Ellen made a motion to approve the Unanimous One Stop Plan and this motion passed. See attached Schedule.

The board discussed adding Sunday hours, as suggested by the State, but did not find that it would be cost effective for this area at this time.

Clause made a motion to use Sunny Days Cleaning Services to Clean the Precincts that does not have a cleaning plan in place due to Covid 19. This motion passed.

Board gave approval to go ahead and purchase the plexi glass shields needed for the precincts. This cost will be reimbursed by the state with funds passed in HB1169.

Larry made a motion to adjourn.
