Once we received the second ballot back we had to send a cure letter per Memo 2020-19 because the witness only signed and did not provide an address or the printed name.


We got the cure letter back on November 4th, and upon going into his record to update it, it was found that he had voted in person at the North Knobs precinct on Election Day.

Ellen Reece made a motion that there was no reason to hold a hearing on this matter. This motion passed.


Jeff Smith made the motion to get Ed Powell, County Attorney, to write an order to send to the Protester and to the North Carolina State Board of Elections.

Walter Shore made a motion to adjourn.




