COUNTY MANAGER'S REPORT

August 25, 2023

Solid Waste

Republic is making more repairs than they originally intended at the transfer station. The cracks in the tipping floor and entry area have been repaired and a lip installed to contain leachate. The wall that was hit with the loader has been repaired. Previously wooden supports have been replaced with metal beams. The exterior wall that had been pushed away from the foundation was reset and additional support beams were installed and cemented four feet deep into the ground. Steel plates are currently being welded into place on the push walls and new cement is being poured at the base of the push walls. A piece of the tipping floor also broke off and fell into the pit. The Construction Company has been instructed by Republic to repair that as well.

We are evaluating the two sites that are only open on Saturdays to determine if they should be manned or unmanned. The Hamptonville site is leased and the building needs to be replaced if the site is going to continue to be manned. The replacement of the building will cost approximately \$20,000.

Finance 101

This class will focus on purchasing requirements in accordance with North Carolina General Statute and County Policy. The County Policy can be found on our website under the Finance Department.
