## **COUNTY MANAGER'S REPORT**

### **April 5, 2024**

#### ***Agriculture Update***

Every five years the USDA releases a Census of Agriculture and the most recent release is of 2022 data. They compare this data to the 2017 data. The number of farms in Yadkin County has decreased 8% since 2017, yet the acreage of land in farm use has increased 12%, as well as the average farm size has increased. The market value of products sold has increased 51%, from \$139,652,000 to \$211,147,000. Exhibit A contains some of the data, not only for Yadkin County, but also Davie, Surry, Wilkes and NC. If you would like more details, please let me know. Agriculture, like everything else is changing.

#### ***Vacancy Report***

This week we have 24 vacancies. Human Services continues to have 13 vacancies this week. Three of the vacancies are in the Sheriff's Office and 3 in Emergency Services. The Tax Assessor's Office has 2 vacancies. Some of these positions have been vacant over 300 days, which in accordance with the County's Personnel Policy positions vacant for 12 months are eliminated.

#### ***FY2025 Budget***

Budget requests for FY2025, with the exception of the Yadkin County Schools are due today. Review of the requests will begin next week.

#### ***State Direct Grants***

The County received the Direct Grant funds from the State this week. We have received the signed Agreements from all of the fire departments and the non-profit groups, with one exception. The Director of that entity said we will receive it this week. Senator Settle will pick-up the checks next week to deliver to the entities.

#### ***Legislative Goals***

It's time to start thinking about Legislative Goals to submit to the NCACC. The submission process will kick-off in May.

Last Monday morning, the ribbon cutting was held for the Library's Story Walk at the Yadkin County Park.
