COUNTY MANAGER'S REPORT AUGUST 4, 2025

Vacancy Report

There are currently 12 vacancies throughout County departments. There are 3 vacancies in Human Services (Nursing Supervisor, Social Worker Child Welfare, Eligibility Supervisor), 3 within the Sheriff's Office (1 Detention Officer and 2 Deputies), 1 in Emergency Services (Paramedic Crew Chief), 2 in Communications (Communications Shift Supervisor and Telecommunicator) one each in Central Permitting, Parks & Recreation, and Finance. Of these positions 6 have been vacant over 30 days and 2 have been vacant for over 100 days.

911 Communications Center

Stewart-Cooper-Newell Architects next week should begin modeling the future 911 Communications Center structure in analysis software to project what upgrades will be required to bring the building into compliance with the Essential Facility Requirements.

Annual Employee Organizational Survey

This week we started working on an employee organizational survey. The survey will be distributed to all employees within the Yadkin County Government organization to allow each employee the opportunity to provide feedback on their department and the organization. The purpose behind the survey will allow employees the opportunity to provide feedback on areas where we are succeeding and areas for improvement. The intent is to make the employee organizational survey an annual process for employees to complete to help us continuously receive feedback on opportunities to improve our organization. All surveys will be anonymous to allow employees to be honest with their responses.
