## **COUNTY MANAGER'S REPORT**

### **October 6, 2025**

#### **Vacancy Report**

There are currently 18 vacancies throughout county departments. There are 2 vacancies in Human Services (Eligibility Supervisor and Child Welfare Social Worker), 5 within the Sheriff's Office (3 Deputies, 1 Detention Officer, and 1 Master Deputy), 2 within the Finance Department (Finance Purchasing Specialist and Finance Technician), 2 in Central Permitting (Senior Building Inspector and Permit Technician) 4 in Emergency Services (3 Paramedics and 1 MIH Paramedic), 2 in Communications (2 Telecommunicator I), 1 in Administration (Economic Development Director). Please note a conditional offer of employment has been accepted by a candidate for the Economic Development Director position. Of these positions 9 have been vacant over 30 days and 2 have been vacant for over 100 days.

#### **Boonville Community Volunteer Fire Department**

The Board of County Commissioners on Monday (10/06) approved the Fire Services Agreement with Boonville Community Volunteer Fire Department. The Boonville Community Volunteer Fire Department Board of Directors approved the Fire Services Agreement with Yadkin County on Wednesday (10/08). Boonville Community Volunteer Fire Department resumed providing fire services to the Boonville District on Thursday (10/09) at 12:00 pm.

#### **Economic Development Director**

This week a candidate accepted a conditional offer of employment to serve as the first Economic Development Director for Yadkin County Government. The candidate will start serving in their role as Economic Development Director in early November.

#### **Hospital Surplus Equipment**

The County has surplus medical equipment at the county-owned hospital. Given the age and limited use of the equipment we have been working towards having a contractor remove and sell the medical equipment. Staff identified Tekyard as a potential contractor that could assist with the removal and sale of the medical equipment. At the October 20<sup>th</sup> Board of County Commissioners' meeting a request will be made by staff to enter into an agreement with Tekyard to remove and sell the surplus equipment in the hospital.
