COUNTY MANAGER'S REPORT

December 8, 2025

Vacancy Report

There are currently 23 vacancies throughout county departments. There are 6 vacancies in the Human Services Agency (3 Eligibility Specialists, Eligibility Supervisor, Child Welfare Social Worker, and Public Health Education Specialist), 3 within the Sheriff's Office (2 Deputies and 1 Master Deputy), 13 in Emergency Services (7 Paramedics, 1 MIH Paramedic, 3 Paramedic Crew Chiefs, 2 Paramedic FTO), and 1 in Communications (Telecommunicator I). Of these positions 7 have been vacant over 30 days and 6 have been vacant for over 100 days.

Landfill Scale Improvements

We had our Landfill Scale Improvements Bid Opening on Friday (12/12) at 12:00 pm. We received one bid from Charlotte Scale for \$125,421.10 to build a new steel deck foundation and install a new scale. The bid from Charlotte Scale will be presented to the Board of County Commissioners at the January 5th meeting for their review and consideration.

Opioid Settlement Funds Strategic Plan

Staff continues to work with Innovative Funding Partners (IFP) on developing the Strategic Plan for utilizing opioid settlement funds that have been provided to Yadkin County. Staff and IFP have started reaching out to stakeholders in the community to receive input on how these funds should be directed to help combat opioid dependency.

Government Administration Building Roof Repairs

The Government Administration Building Roof was damaged by a recent weather event. The County received \$42,552.80 from our insurance provider to cover roofing repairs. Industrial Solutions was selected to provide the roofing repairs. They started making repairs to the roof a few weeks ago and are approximately 50 percent complete with the roofing project.

LIEAP Update

The Low-Income Energy Assistance Program (LIEAP) is a federally funded program that provides for a one-time vendor payment to help eligible households pay their heating bills. The recent Federal Government shutdown impacted disbursement of these funds. LIEAP Funding has returned to local governments and citizens may start submitting applications on Wednesday (12/10) for funding.
