



How to Properly Discard Your Old Televisions, Computers, and Other Electronics

Did you know?

NCGS 130A-309.130-130A-309.141 "Discarded Computer Equipment and Television Management" establishes an electronics recycling program for the State of North Carolina. In conjunction with this program, the law bans televisions, computers, monitors, printers, scanners, and associated electronics from disposal in landfills.

To assist the citizens of Yadkin County in discarding old electronics ("e-waste"), we offer the following options :

- Manufacturer and retailer take-back programs are available at various electronic stores and over the Internet.
- If the electronics are still working, consider donating to a thrift store such as Goodwill; Salvation Army etc...
- Area recycling centers that take electronics.
- Drop off at Yadkin County Solid Waste located at: 1149 Landfill Road Yadkinville, N.C..

Drop off Monday- Friday from 8:00 am until 4:30 pm

Saturdays from 8:00 am until 2:00 pm

Items accepted include: TV's; computers; monitors; printers; scanners; keyboards; Telephones; copiers; VCR's; microwaves; radios; and other non-hazardous electronics.

Fees for services:

TV's and computers up to 32" and completely intact	\$6.00
TV's and computers up to 32" broken and/or missing parts	\$10.00
TV's and computers over 32" and completely intact	\$10.00
TV's and computers over 32" broken and/or missing parts	\$20.00
All other items (listed above)	No Charge
