Yadkin County Employee Wellness Clinic Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Who can use the Yadkin County Employee Wellness Clinic and how much does it cost?

Any adult employee, dependent or retiree enrolled in the county's health insurance plan can use the clinic for free with no co-pay.

Will I have to sit in a waiting room full of sick people when I come to the clinic?

No. If you have an appointment, or you called prior and were told to come right over, we will typically see you immediately. The clinic is *only* open to Yadkin County employees so you will never be waiting with the general public to see a health care provider.

Where is the clinic? When is it open? How do I make an appointment?

The clinic is located in the former Yadkin County Community Hospital and is staffed with a Nurse Practitioner and a Nurse weekly Monday - Friday from 8 am – 4:30 pm (closed 12:30 pm – 1:00 pm for lunch). Appointments are easy and you can often get one the same day. Please call our providers for your next healthcare concern at 336-849-7777.

I don't want my coworkers and managers to know about my health issue and lifestyle choices so why would I go to an "employee clinic"?

The clinic is operated by an independent company (IEH Solutions LLC) that is legally required to keep your visit information and health-related data private. Your personal health information will never be shared with any employee of Yadkin County or other outside agency without your written consent. IEHS takes the responsibility for privacy very seriously.
