Yadkin County Government will open the Yadkin County Hospital (624 West Main Street, Yadkinville) to serve as an Emergency Shelter starting at 8:00 pm today (01/24). Entry into the Shelter will be through the Main Hospital Entrance circle drive through. This Shelter will have Meals Ready-to-Eat (MRES), heated spaces, and beds for any individual seeking shelter. Please note that for all individuals that use the Shelter you will be required to adhere to a curfew that prohibits you from leaving the facility after you enter the facility. Below is a list of Allowable Items to Bring and Non-Allowable Items in the Shelter:

Allowable Items to Bring	Non-Allowable Items
Personal Medications	Firearms, weapons, or ammunition
Medical Equipment and Supplies Needed for Daily Use	Smoking or vaping of any kind
Identification	Alcohol, illegal or synthetic drugs
Personal Hygiene Items	Narcotics not prescribed to the individual
Clothing and footwear	Non-prescription syringes or needles
Pillows or sleeping items	Candles, hot plates, or cooking devices
Cell phones, chargers, and battery packs	
Glasses, hearing aids, and related supplies	
Books and quiet activities	
Infant and child supplies	

Individuals are allowed to bring companion animals to the facility. Additional shelters can be opened at a later time by the County depending upon sheltering needs. Shelter participants will be notified in advance of shelter closure so arrangement can be made for transport home (if applicable). This is a short-term, temporary shelter, so please plan accordingly.
